



Consultation on proposed Admission Arrangements for Oaklands Infant School for entry in September 2022

Introduction

Oaklands Infant School is an academy school. The Corvus Learning Trust is the admission authority for the school. When an admission authority wishes to make changes to their admission arrangements, they must consult to ensure all views are heard. The Corvus Learning Trust is consulting on the following change to the admission arrangements for Oaklands Infant School:

Proposed change to the oversubscription criteria:

- Amend the sibling criterion to include those also attending Oaklands Junior School.

Why are we proposing this change?

As both schools (Infants & Juniors) are on the same site, we often have siblings from the same families in our schools. We are known as Oaklands Schools and we value our parent community. We would therefore like to ensure that families who have a child in Oaklands Junior School would also then have a clear priority in the criteria for admission of any brother or sister to Oaklands Infant school.
